

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 430

WHEREAS, The Papago Council on July 8, 1949 authorized the Chairman of the Papago Council to place an order for a new pickup truck for the use of the Tribal Office, and

WHEREAS, A new pickup truck has now been purchased and received,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, By the Papago Council that payment for said truck in the amount of \$832.05 be made from the Miscellaneous Fund, PT-7, Fiscal Year 1950.

PROVIDED: That payments for operations, maintenance and repairs be made from PT-5A as provided in Resolution No. 417, Budget of the Papago Council for the Fiscal Year 1950.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1949, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936; and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to 16 of the act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 924). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
