## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

110. 431

WHEREAS, There is now a vacancy in the Papago Tribal Court due to the resignation of Mark Manuel, Judge of the Tribal Court, effective October 1, 1949,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved that Ricardo Manuel of Sells District be recommended to the Commissioner of Indian Affairs for promotion from Associate Judge to Judge of the Tribal Court.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1949, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (b) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
