## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, The Papago Council on January 7, 1949 appointed David Jose to the Papago Loan Board to fill the vacancy left by Jose J. Carrillo, and

WHEREAS, David Jose has been convicted in the Papago Tribal Court of criminal charges unbecoming of the respect and dignity of his position and in violation to the set policy of the Papago Council,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved that in accordance with the set policy of the Papago Council, David Jose be removed from membership in the Papago Loan Board and that the vacancy be filled by the Papago Council.

The foregoing resolution was on November 4, 1949, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (e) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on Recember 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1934, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat.984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
