

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 669

WHEREAS: The Papago Council on September 5, 1952, authorized the purchase of a new 1952 Chevrolet, Model, 3104-CCBX, $\frac{1}{2}$ ton pick-up for the use of the Papago Council and the Tribal Office; and

WHEREAS: Such a pick-up has been purchased, but payment has not yet been made;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL: That payment in the amount of \$1,766.80 be made to O'REILLY MOTOR CO. of Tucson, Arizona for the new 1952 Chevrolet, Model, 3104-CCBX, $\frac{1}{2}$ ton pick-up, Motor No. BKCA 509556, Serial No. 20KPH 4729;

PROVIDED: That the payment for the above mentioned pick-up truck shall be made from Account PT-1, General Fund; and

PROVIDED FURTHER: That adequate insurance coverage shall be obtained, the premium for which insurance coverage to be paid from Account PT-5A, TRIBAL TRUCK OPERATION, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS; and

PROVIDED FINALLY: That the payment for Operation, Maintenance, and Repairs to the above mentioned $\frac{1}{2}$ ton Chevrolet pick-up shall be made from Account PT-5A, Tribal Truck Operation, Maintenance, and Repairs.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1953, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section (3) a, Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on December 12, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
