

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 670

WHEREAS: Resolution No. 668 of the Papago Council terminated Norbert Leonard from the position of Tribal Caretaker and Jailer, effective as of December 31, 1952;


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL: That Francisco Johnson of Sells, Arizona, be and is hereby appointed Tribal Caretaker and Jailer at a salary of \$125.00 per month, such appointment to be effective as of January 1, 1953;

PROVIDED: That he shall serve in accordance with the provisions of Resolution Nos. 615, 641 and 651.


The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1953, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (e) Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 19, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior.


