

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHEREAS: Mark Manuel, Loan Board Manager, has been incapacitated by illness for a much longer period than was anticipated so that the loan program has been seriously affected;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL: That Enos Francisco be appointed to the position of temporary Loan Board Manager to serve in that capacity and to assume all of the duties and responsibilities of the Loan Board Manager until such a time as Mark Manuel is able to resume his duties;

RESOLVED: That Enos Francisco shall serve at a salary of \$150.00 per month, said salary to be paid from Account PT-124, Papago Loan Board Operation; and

PROVIDED FURTHER: That said Enos Francisco shall give bond to the Papago Tribe for the faithful performance of his duties in the sum of \$5,000, the premium on the bond to be paid from Account PT-12A, Papago Loan Board Operation; and

RESOLVED FURTHER: That the appointment of said Enos Francisco be effective as of the date of February 1, 1953.

The foregoing resolution was on February 6, 1953, duly enacted by a vote of 15 For and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (c), 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the resolution by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
