

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 677

WHEREAS: The Papago Tribe of Arizona as petitioner has already filed a petition for a General Accounting and a Land petition before the Indian Claims Commission of the United States; and

WHEREAS: The Papago Council is presently investigating further its claims against the United States of America.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL: That Narcho Ferguson, Richard Hendricks, Henry Throssell, Juan Jose, and Albert Antone be and are hereby appointed to the Claims Committee of The Papago Council,

PROVIDED: That the members of the Claims Committee of The Papago Council shall serve in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 394 of The Papago Council; and


PROVIDED FURTHER: That they shall serve indefinitely at the pleasure of The Papago Council but that failure to attend three (3) consecutive meetings without cause shall be deemed sufficient grounds for removal; and

PROVIDED FINALLY: That the expenses of the Claims Committee shall be paid from Account #1-5, Papago Tribe, Travel Expenses, Papago Council Committees and Officers.


The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1953, duly enacted by the Papago Council by a vote of 18 for and 0 against pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (e), Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 981). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
