RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 681

MIFREAS: The report submitted to The Papago Council on the annual and sick leave accumulations and accruals of Mark Manuel from the date of his imittal employment to the date of his termination by resignation was confusing;

THEREFORE HE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL: That George Morris, Enos Francisco, Juan Jose, Louis Harvey and Joe Adams be appointed as a committee to investigate the annual and sick leave accumulations and accruals of Mark Manuel from the date of his initial employment to the date of his termination by resignation as Loan Board Manager and that a comparison be made with the annual and sick leave payments received by tark Manuel for the consideration of The Papago Council;

PROVIDED: That the above Committee shall receive compensation in accordance with Resolution No. 621; and

PROVIDED FINALLY: That the Committee shall serve only until it has submitted its report to the Papago Council whereupon it shall be disolved.

The foregoing resolution was on May 1, 1953, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority respect in it by Section (2) e, and 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on Recember 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Tamuary 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6 Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
