WHEREAS: In accordance with resolution No. 680 the Papago Council accepted the resignation of [Name],

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL: That **Rnos Francisco** be appointed to the position of **Member** of the Papago Loan Board at a salary of **\$150.00 per month**, effective June 1, 1953,

PROVIDED: That such salary be paid from **PT-12A, Papago Tribal Loan Board Operation**, in accordance with the annual budget of the Papago Tribal Loan Board.

The foregoing resolution was on May 22, 1953, duly enacted by a vote of 10 for and 4 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (e), 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 904). Said resolution is in full force as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Indian Affairs, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and the laws of the Papago Tribe.
