RESOLUTION

THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

for allowances

\$3,425.00

WHEREAS: The budget of the Papago Tribal Court and Law & Order Operations has been submitted to the Papago Council for consideration; and

WHEREAS: The Papago Council finds that the Papago Tribal Court expended \$11,313.19 during fiscal year 1953, although its budget was only \$7,850.00, necessitating borrowing from the General Fund to meet the overexpenditures;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL: That a budget of \$6,850.00 be approved for the Papago Tribal Court and Law & Order Operations for the Fiscal Year 1954 and the Court be strictly enjoined to keep its expenditures within this figure; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the employment of the Court Clerk be limited to one-half time during Fiscal Year 1954, previous actions of this Council notwithstanding;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Superintendent of Papago Agency be requested and authorized to transfer immediately the sum of \$3,425.00 from Account PT-8, Papago Tribe, General Fund, to Account PT-8A, Papago Tribal Court and Law & Order Operations, and on January 1, 1954 to transfer an additional sum of \$3,425.00 from Account PT-8 to Account PT-8A; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Superintendent of Papago Agency be requested and authorized to transfer as soon as it is available the sum of \$3,425.00 from Account PT-8, Papago Tribe, Court Fund to Account PT-1, Papago Tribe, General Fund, and on January 1, 1954 or as soon thereafter as available to transfer an additional sum of \$3,425.00 from Account PT-8 to Account PT-1; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That all receipts of the Papago Tribal Court 1954 be deposited in Account PT-8, Papago Tribe, Court Fund; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That at the end of Fiscal Year 1954 all unexpended funds in Account PT-8A, Papago Court and Law & Order Operations shall revert to Account PT-1, Papago Tribe, Court Fund; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED: That the Secretary & Treasurer be hereby authorized to sign vouchers for expenditures from Account PT-8A in the amounts and for the purposes called for in the following approved budget;
