

RESOLUTION

THE PAPAGO COUNCIL -

Business Meeting
November 1954

WHEREAS: The Finance Committee has presented to the Papago Council for its consideration a proposed budget for the expenses of the Papago Council for Fiscal Year 1954, and

WHEREAS: The Papago Council finds that this proposed budget represents a reduction of 200 from its expenditures during Fiscal Year 1953, that it approximates the estimated income of the Council for Fiscal Year 1954, and that it represents a reasonable estimate of what the Council's operations should cost,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL: That a budget of \$17,000.00 be approved for the operations of the Papago Council for Fiscal Year 1954, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Superintendent of Papago Agency be requested and authorized to transfer, as they become available, from Account PT-1, Yavapai Tribe, General Fund, the amounts listed below to the accounts listed below, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That all unexpended funds remaining in these accounts at the end of Fiscal Year 1954 shall revert to Account PT-1, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED: That the Secretary and Treasurer be hereby authorized to sign vouchers for expenditures from the Accounts listed below in the amounts and for the purposes listed below,

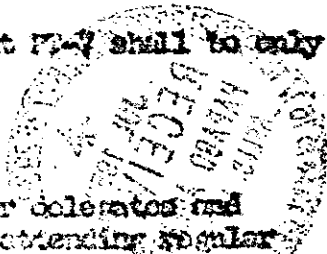
PROVIDED: That expenditures from Account PT-7 shall be only upon Resolution of the Papago Council:

TO

PT-2 For travel and meeting expenses for delegates and officers of the Papago Council in attending regular and special meetings of the Council, whether or not there be a quorum, PROVIDED, that only mileage allowance be paid when there is not a quorum present. \$3,650.00

PT-3 For stationary, office supplies and equipment, tele- phones and telegraph tolls, postage, utilities, etc. ... \$500.00

PT-4 For salaries of Tribal employees, including Social Security taxes and Bond Premiums \$5,200.00

PT-5	For travel and expenses of Council Committee members and officers of the Papago Council in attending such Committee meetings as it may be necessary for them to attend in the performance of their authorized duties. (3,500.00)	
PT-5A	For the purchase and operation of Tribal trucks	2,100.00
PT-6	For maintenance, repairs and improvement, and insurance to the Tribal Community Building	1,200.00
PT-7	For miscellaneous purposes not included in the above accounts, to be expended only under resolution of the Papago Council	500.00

The foregoing resolution was on July 24, 1953, duly adopted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against by the Papago Council in accordance to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Territory and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
