

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 693

WHEREAS: A considerable amount of work has been done in order to complete the construction of the rodeo grandstand and repairs to the bleachers so that an overdraft has resulted in Account PT-18, Papago Tribe, Fair & Rodeo Grandstand Construction;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL: That the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be instructed to transfer the sum of \$19.29 from Account PT-1, Papago Tribe, General Fund, to Account PT-18, Papago Tribe, Fair & Rodeo Grandstand Construction.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1953, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6 Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
