

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 698

WHEREAS: The Budget of the Papago Council for Fiscal Year 1954 has not yet been agreed upon; and

WHEREAS: Authority is needed for necessary expenditures from Tribal Funds pending the approval of the Budget,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL: That the Superintendent of Papago Agency be hereby authorized to expend, upon the receipt of properly prepared vouchers, the following sums:

From Accounts PT-2 through PT-7	\$1,000.00
Account PT-8A	1,000.00
Account PT-9C	1,000.00
Account PT-10A	500.00
Account PT-12A	500.00
TOTAL . . .	<u>\$4,000.00</u>

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Superintendent of Papago Agency be authorized to transfer such funds as may be necessary to permit the above expenditures from the receipt accounts of the Papago Tribe to the above expenditure accounts.

PROVIDED: That any expenditures under this resolution shall become expenditures under the Budget when such Budget is approved.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1953, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 944). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
