

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1003

WHEREAS, A telephone line is necessary for the new farm development in the Molenitus area of the Chukut Kuk district, and

WHEREAS, Such a telephone line will make for better communication between the Farm project, the Papago Council, and the Papago Indian Agency, and

WHEREAS, Authorization of the right of way will make it possible for the area along the line to receive telephone service in the future, such service to be subject to agreement between the Districts involved and the Bureau of Indian Affairs regarding location and other details, and also subject to the availability of funds and/or materials to do the work, and

WHEREAS, The District Council of Chukut Kuk District passed a recommendation to approve that part of the telephone right of way in its District at a meeting held June 14, 1958, at which a quorum was present, and the Sells District Council also passed a recommendation to approve the right of way in Sells District at a meeting held June 16, 1958, at which a quorum was present;

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED By the Papago Tribal Council that the Council grant a telephone line right of way to the United States of America, said right of way to be 25 feet wide and to run in accordance with the alignment as specified in the Resolution previously approved by the Chukut Kuk District Council and the Sells District Council.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 18, 1958, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
