tor WHEREAS, it is the understanding of the Papago Tribal Council that the Glasscock of Tidelands Oil Company cancelled their lease with the Tribe at Geowic Well, but have now asked that the cancellation be withdrawn and the lease renewed on the plant same basis as previously, and

WHEREAS, the Glasscock-Tidelands Oil Company believes there is a possibility that the mill may be operated again, either by them, or by someone who may buy the equipment, and

WHENEAS, the Council, subject to approval of a similar Resolution by Schuk Toak District Council, wishes to recommend that the lease be renewed on the same terms except for the standby rate of \$20 per month, which is believes should be increased;

THEHEFORE, LET BE RESOLVED THAT the Papago Tribal Council, subject to Schuk Toak District Council approval, recommend that the lease with the Glasscock-Tidelands Oil Company be renewed on the same basis as their old lease with the following exception: that a minimum standby rate of \$25.00 per month be required instead of the old rate of \$20.00 per month, but that the Chairman be directed to negotiate for the highest standby rate possible.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 18, 1958, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V and Section 4 Article VIII of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1937, (h8 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 3 (h) of Article V and Section 4 of Article VIII of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
