

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RFS. NO. 1005

WHEREAS, The assignees on the East Chuichu project have asked permission to lease and farm jointly the following tract which the Council understands has been relinquished:

Tract 68 A & B - - 80 acres, and

WHEREAS, The assignees wish to lease the plots on the same basis as they leased tracts No. 66A and B, namely -

1. No payment to be made to the Tribe the first year. All proceeds from crops the first year to be used for operating costs on the project, it being understood this includes all expenses such as water assessments, any liens on equipment being purchased from the Farm Home Ad. by the previous assignee, and all other charges incident to the farming of this plot.
2. The second year and each year thereafter the group agrees to pay a flat rate of \$5.00 per acre to the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, The assignees have made formal application for a lease in a letter dated June 19, 1958, and the Papago Council is willing to authorize a lease on the above basis; it being understood that the Tribe will not be asked to assume any of the costs of operation;

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be authorized to lease the described plot as outlined above, in accordance with all applicable Bureau of Indian Affairs regulations, and that the Tribal Chairman be allowed to enter into such a lease on behalf of the Tribal Council.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 18, 1958, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1937, (48 Stat. 904). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
