RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL.

REC. NO. 1027

WHEREAS, The salary and expenses of C. J. Higgin, Administrative Assistant to the Tribal Chairman, will be paid from contributed funds until February 1, 1959, as stated in Resolution No. 227 of June 16, 1958, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Internal Revenue has approved a plan whereby such contributions can be deducted for income tax purposes if the contributions are made to the American Friends Service Committee, and turned over to the Tribe by the American Friends Service Committee for payment to the Administrative Assistant, and

WHEREAS, it appears the most practical way to handle this matter is to put Mr. Higgin on the Tribal payroll, with the understanding that payment of his salary and expenses up to February 1, 1959, will be made only from contributed funds;

THEFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it put C. J. Higgin on the Tribal payroll, retroactive to April 1, 1958, and that it request the Papago Agency to handle these contributed funds in a manner which will be adequate to insure they will be used only to pay salary and expenses of the Administrative Assistant and that the Agency make payments out of available Contributed funds on presentation of properly authorized Tribal Vouchers.

The foregoing resolution was approved on July 10, 1958, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 924). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
