RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL,

Res. No. 1010

WHEREAS, The Baboquivari District Council has submitted its Resolution No. 7 covering its proposed budget for the Fiscal Year 1959, and

WHEREAS, The District had a balance of \$2896.81 as of June 30, 1958 in the U. S. Treasury and the IIM account and anticipates its revenue during the 1959 fiscal year at \$1,000.

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: by the Papago Council that the Baboquivari District Budget for Fiscal Year 1959 be approved as follows:


1. Gasoline for pump operation	\$750.00
2. Salt for livestock	400.00
3. Office equipment and supplies	50.00
4. Miscellaneous expenses	50.00
5. Range improvements, to be expended only by resolution of the District Council	<u>700.00</u>
	<u>\$1,950.00</u>

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the Treasurer of Baboquivari District be authorized to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the above amounts, and that the Treasurer of the Papago Council be authorized to sign vouchers for the payment of these orders against the Revolving Fund of the Papago Tribe, IIM Account PM-1F.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District be authorized to draw from its available funds in the U. S. Treasury if this is necessary.

The foregoing resolution was on August 1, 1958, duly enacted by the Papago Council with a vote of 22 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 10, 1934 (49 Stat.). This resolution is effective as of the date of its enactment.
