

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1012

WHEREAS, the Vaya Chin, Kaka, Ventana Cattle Association has presented its budget for Fiscal Year 1959 to the Papago Council for approval, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council has considered this budget and finds it reasonable and within the ability of the Association to finance.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY the Papago Council that the sum of \$800.00 be appropriated from the Revolving Fund of the Tribe to cover the Fiscal Year 1959 budget of the Vaya Chin, Kaka, Ventana Cattle Association, and that the Treasurer be heroby authorized to sign Purchase Orders and Vouchers against Account PT-10 for the following purposes in the following amounts:

1. Gasoline & Oil for Pumps at Wells	\$275.00
2. Repairs to Well Facilities	100.00
3. Corral & Pasture Repairs	250.00
4. Roundup Supplies	175.00
Total	<u>\$800.00</u>

The foregoing Resolution was on August 1, 1958, duly enacted by a vote of 22 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
