## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1013

WEREAS, Some district funds are on deposit in the U.S. Treasury and some in the local IIM Account, and

WHEREAS, Some of the Districts may need to use Treasury funds in connection with expenses contemplated in their budgets for fiscal year 1959, and

WEREAS, The Agency has suggested that this will be facilitated if the Tribal Council pass an appropriate Resolution requesting authority for Districts to use these funds if needed.

THEREFORE, HET IT HE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it request the Agency to release available district funds now in the U.S. Treasury upon request of the District, supported by properly authorized Papago Tribal wouchers.

The foregoing resolution was approved on August 1, 1958, duly enacted by a vote of 22 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 3 (a) of Article of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
