

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1014

WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council has submitted its Resolution covering its proposed budget for the Fiscal Year 1959, and

WHEREAS, the District has a balance of \$1,753.35 as of June 30, 1958 in the U.S. Treasury and the IIM account and anticipates its revenue during the 1959 fiscal year at 750.00.

WHEREAS, the Papago Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Papago Council that the Sif Oidak District Budget for Fiscal Year 1959 be approved as follows:

1. Labor and material for fencing	\$350.00
2. Labor and material to repair boundary fences	550.00
3. Gas and Oil for Pumps	500.00
4. Labor and Material to move Chui-Chu corral and scales	1100.00
5. Labor and Material to build new loading chute at Jackrabbit	600.00
6. Labor and material to build new loading chute at Conlie	600.00
7. Miscellaneous	300.00
Total	<u>\$4,300.00</u>

PROVIDED FURTHER, that the Treasurer of the Sif Oidak District be authorized to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the above amounts, and that the Treasurer of the Papago Council be authorized to sign vouchers for the payment of these orders against the Revolving Fund of the Papago Tribe, IIM Account IT-1P.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the District be authorized to draw from its available funds in the U. S. Treasury if this is necessary.

The foregoing resolution was on August 1, 1958, duly enacted by the Papago Council with a vote of 22 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its enactment.
