

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1015

WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council at a special meeting held July 7, 1958 at which a quorum was present, approved a right of way for the Arizona Highway Department to straighten State Highway 86 in vicinity of Covered Wells:

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the Papago Council that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency issue a Right of Way to Arizona Highway Department in accordance with the conditions outlined in the Gu Achi Resolution.

The foregoing Resolution was approved on August 1, 1958, duly enacted by a vote of 22 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
