

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1019

WHEREAS, the agricultural lease held by E. L. Sisson, Gila Bend, Arizona for certain lands on the Gila Bend Indian Reservation, Arizona, will expire December 31, 1958, and

WHEREAS, the question of renewing the lease has been considered by the District Council which has decided it would be more advantageous to continue leasing the lands rather than have the District Council or individual Indians or a group of Indians operate the lands as a farming project, the lands consisting of all of Section 7, and the W $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, G & SH $\frac{1}{4}$ , Arizona, containing 720 acres, more or less;

THEREFORE, BE IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be authorized to issue a farming lease on the above described land, in accordance with applicable Federal Regulations, that the lease be issued in a manner which will bring the most benefit to the District and Tribal Council, that one-half of the rental proceeds be deposited to the credit of the Gila Bend District Council and one-half to the Papago Council, and that the Chairman of the Council be authorized to sign the lease on behalf of the Papago Council.

The foregoing resolution was September 5, 1958, duly enacted by a vote of 20 for and 0 against by the Papago Council during a meeting at which a quorum was present pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 4 of Article VIII of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 4 of Article VIII of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
