WHEREAS, the Papago Rodeo Board has submitted the following budget at its meeting held September 4, 1958.

Labor - Repairs to corrals	\$ 100.00
Rent on cattle, 45 head @ \$4.00 per day	360.00
Rent on horses, 20 head @ \$4.00 per day	160.00
Printing	95.00
Orchestra- two nights	100.00
Electrical repairs	75.00
Rodeo labor	250.00
Miscellaneous: prizes, ribbons, etc.	60.00

WHEREAS, the Papago Council feels that this is a reasonable budget, because it corresponds to the amount of receipts taken in during last year's rodeo;

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Budget presented by the Rodeo Board be approved and that the Board be instructed to keep expenses within the budget figures.

the foregoing resolution was on September 5, 1958, duly enacted by a vote of 20 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 10, 1934, (48 Stat. 934). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
