RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1021

WHEREAS, On March 5, 1958, the Schuk Toak District Council approved the leasing of land on Kitt Peak in accordance with a proposal of March 1, 1958, made by the Association of Universities for Research in Astronomy, Inc., acting for the National Science Foundation, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council gave its approval for the lease in Resolution 976 of March 7, 1958, and

WHEREAS, It was understood by the Council that the lease could not be signed until the National Science Foundation had approved the proposed terms, and until it was authorized by an Act of Congress, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior, and

WHEREAS, The lease is in accordance with the proposal of March 1, 1958, including a bonus of \$25,000.00, and an annual rental rate as agreed upon, one-half of the bonus and annual rental rate to go to the Schuk Toak District Council, and one-half to the Papago Council, and

WHEREAS, the National Science Foundation has approved the terms, the necessary law has been passed by Congress and signed by President Eisenhower, the lease has been recommended by the Secretary of the Interior, and is awaiting the signature of the Chairman of the Papago Council, and then the Secretary of the Interior to make it final;

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the lease be approved and that the Chairman of the Papago Council be authorized to sign such lease on behalf of the Papago Tribe.

On October 3, 1958, the foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council with a vote of 15 for and 0 against, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VIII, Section 4, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe, Arizona, and by the Act of Congress dated August 28, 1958, Public Law 85-816 (72 Stat. 901). This resolution is effective as of the date of its enactment.
