## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1022

WERLAS, when the Rodeo Budget was set up on September 4, 1958, and approved September 5, by Resolution No. 1020 no funds were included for per diem by travel for the Rodeo Committee, who are responsible for the successe of the Annual Papago Rodeo, and

VARIETAS, the Rodeo Committee believes that if a sum of \$500, were set aside for this expense, with the provision that any surplus be returned if not used, this amount will take care of possible expense in this connection;

THEREFORE, HET IT HE HESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the sum of \$500. be appropriated to cover possible per diem and travel allowances for members of the Rodeo Committee, these expenses to be supported by written records and receipted copies of bills, and any surplus to be returned to Tribal revolving fund.

The foregoing resolution was on October 3, 1958, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and O against by the Papago Council, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vest in it by Section 3 (a) Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
