

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 1024

WHEREAS, One of the conditions stipulated by Thomas Childs for deeding certain lands to the United States of America, in trust for the Papago Tribe, was that the children of Thomas Childs and Martha Lopez Childs, his wife, be adopted as members of the Papago Tribe, and

WHEREAS, It has now been found that Martha Lopez Childs, also known as Martha Thomas Childs, is shown as a 1938 addition on the January 1, 1940, Tribal census, which is accordance with Article II, Section (a) of the Papago Constitution, and

WHEREAS, This enrollment makes it possible to adopt the Child's children in accordance with Article II, Section 1 (b) of the Papago Constitution;

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the following children of Thomas Childs and Martha Childs be adopted as members of the Papago Tribe, and that they shall have all the rights and privileges enjoyed by other members of the Tribe:
