

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 1027

WHEREAS, the Papago Agency will be in need of larger facilities for the storage of water to take care of the increased needs of the Agency, the Sells community, and the new hospital to be constructed at Sells in the near future, and

WHEREAS, The best location for a new water tank appears to be on top of the knoll which has the Wahoo Triangulation Point located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, T 17S, R4E, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, The Sells District Council approved the granting of one acre said site as an Agency Reserve at a meeting held on November 10, 1958, at which a quorum was present, by a vote of 13 for and 0 against;

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that one acre on the above site be granted to the Papago Agency as a Reserve to erect and maintain a water storage tank, the exact description of the land and a map to be furnished at a later date, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that approval of said site shall also include the necessary rights of way for pipelines and power lines needed in connection with the erection and maintenance of this tank.

The foregoing resolution was on December 19, 1958, duly enacted by a vote of 21 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (a) & (c) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its enactment.
