RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 2001

WHEREAS, In order to try to handle the increased volume of work in the Tribal Office it has been necessary to hire a part time employee, which has been done in accordance with Resolution 1052 passed by the Council, and

WHEREAS; Harry Marcus has been hired on a part time basis, being well qualified because of his past experience doing office work in the army, so he has been able to do a lot more work than a person without experience could have done, and

WHEREAS, He has been hired at the rate of \$1.25 per hour, and money is available in the budget of tribal employees to pay him, and

WHEREAS, If it appears necessary to hire a full time employee at a later date, a request will be brought to the Council for approval.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it confirm the employment of Harry Marcus as a part time Tribal employee and approve the hourly rate of \$1.25 per hour now being paid to him, it being understood that no set schedule of hours can be set for him because of other activities such as round-up work he has to do, and that he will work for the Tribe as he has the time.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on April 1, 1960, with a vote of 21 for O against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3 (a) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
