

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1110

WHEREAS, The Schuk Toak District Council met on May 31, 1960 at which a quorum was present and approved a budget for the 1961 fiscal year, and has submitted it to the Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, The District had a balance of \$11,157.46 on April 30, 1960 and expects its revenue during the 1961 fiscal year to be \$3,500, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Schuk Toak District Budget for the 1961 be approved as follows: to cover expenses for engine and well repair in the villages, for the purchase of gasoline, and for other expenses which the villages may consider necessary:

Bill Nakya	100.00
Comobshi	100.00
Queen's Well	100.00
Garcia Ranch	100.00
Insurance, License, and Repairs for Truck	250.00

It is understood that the money spent will be used for the needs of the villages named, and any amount not used will be considered as remaining a part of the District account.

Mester Francisco is authorized to approve in writing any requests for expenditures by the villages.

Passed at a meeting held May 31, 1960, at which a quorum was present, by a vote of 7 for and 0 against.

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Budget submitted by the Schuk Toak District be approved.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on June 3, 1960 with a vote of 17 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3 (a) and (h) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
