RECOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1111

WHITHEAS, The San Xavier Dictrict Council met on May 31, 1960 at which a chorum was present, the Council approved a budget for the 1951 fiscal year, and has submitted it to the Tribal Council, and

WHENFAS, The District had a belence of \$3,096.59 on April 30, 1960 and expects its revenue during the 1961 fiscal year to be \$600.00, and

WHEREAG. The Papage Tribal Council has considered the proposed bidget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

THIRRIDER, LIT IT DE RESOLVED that the can Kayler District Budget for the 1961 be approved as follows: \$500.00 to be spent for the following purposes:

- 1. To buy material to build new benches for the Commity Hall (Stone House)
- 2: To buy material to repair the roof of the Community Rall. (Stone House)
- 3. For a sign board to be sade and painted for creation at the entrance to the Reservation, and also for roads signs to be made and painted.

Passed May 31, 1960, at a mosting of the San Lavier District Council. held May 31, by a vote of 7 for and 0 against.

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESULVED BY the Papers Council that the Budget submitted by the fan Xavier District be approved.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on June 3; 1969 with a vote of 17 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a guerum was prosent, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3 (a) and (h) of the Constitution of the Tribe retified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuent to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
