

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1114

WHEREAS, The Chukot Kuk District Council passed the following Resolution at a District meeting held on May 21, 1960, at which a quorum was present.

WHEREAS, The Chukot Kuk District Council had \$4,302.63 in its District IIM account in the Papago Agency on April 30, 1960, plus \$6,000 from the Papago Faras lease being temporarily held in the Agency suspense account, and

WHEREAS, The District Council approved a budget of \$2,000 for the 1961 fiscal year, leaving surplus fund of approximately \$10,302.63 in the account, and

WHEREAS, The District Council wishes to deposit its surplus funds in federally insured savings account in a commercial bank in Tucson so the funds will earn the regular rate of interest on such accounts, which is now 3%, and

WHEREAS, The members of the Chukot Kuk District Council considering this matter have been duly selected in accordance with District procedure, and its officers, who have been duly elected by the Council, are Joseph Martin, Chairman, Archie Hendricks, Secretary, and Ramon Chavez, Treasurer.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Chukot Kuk District Council that \$8,000.00 be transferred from the Chukot Kuk District IIM account in the Papago Agency and be deposited in an insured savings account in the main office of the Valley National Bank of Tucson, and that Mr. Harry W. Gilmore, Superintendent of the Papago Agency, be designated by the District to act as Trustee of this savings account, making deposits to it from the IIM account, or withdrawals to be placed in the IIM account, in accordance with resolutions properly passed by the Chukot Kuk District Council. "

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED By the Papago Tribal Council that it approve the resolution of the Chukot Kuk District Council, and that it recommend that Chukot Kuk District deposit its surplus funds in the manner above outlined.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on June 3, 1960 with a vote of 17 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3 (a) and (h) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
