RESULUTION OF THE PAFAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1111

UNITERS, The Chikut lok District Council passed the following Resolution at a District meeting held on Hay 21, 1960, at which a quorum was present.

M WILLIEAS, The Chakut Ruk District Council had fly, 302.63 in its Metrict III ascount in the Papage Agency on April 30, 1960, plus \$6,000 from the Papago Farms lease being temporarily held in the Agency sispense account, and

WHEREAS, The District Council approved a budget of \$2,000 for the 1961 fiscal year, looving surplus fund of approximately \$10,302.63 in the account, and

WHIREAS, The District Council wishes to deposit its surplus funds in federally insured savings account in a commercial bank in Tuesen so the funds will earn the regular rate of interest on such accounts, which is now 3%, and

WHIREAS, The members of the Chukut Ruk District Council considering this matter have been duly selected in accordance with Metrics procedure, and its officers, who have been duly elected by the Council, are Joseph Martin, Chairman, Archie Hendricks, Secretary, and Romon Chaves, Tressurer.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RECOLVED by the Chikut hik Electrica Council that \$5,000.00 be transferred from the Chekut Kuk Elstrict IIN account in the Papago Agency and be deposited in an insured savings account in the main office of the Valley National Bank of Tueson, and that Hr. Harry W. Gilmere, Superintendent of the Papago Agency, be decignated by the District to act as Trustee of this savings account, making deposits to it from the IIH account; or withdrawals to be placed in the IIM account, in accordance with resolutions properly passed by the Gulmt fuk Dietrict Council. "

THIREFORE, LET IT DE ENCOLVED By the Papago Tribal Council-that it approve the resolution of the Chukut Kuk District Council, and that it recommend that Chokut Kuk District deposit its surplus Aunds in the monner above outlined.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on June 3, 1960 with a vote of 17 for and b against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuent to enthority vested in it by Article V, Section 3 (a) and (h) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 state 984).
