

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1119

WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council met on June 19, 1960, with a quorum present, and the Council approved a budget for the fiscal year 1961 by a vote of 7 to 0, which has been submitted to the Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the District has a balance of \$3165.03 in its District Account as of May 31, 1960, and expects an income of about \$1500 for the 1961 fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed budget and considers it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Sif Oidak District Budget be approved as follows:

\$1,500.00 for the 1961 fiscal year, the money to be used for various purposes in the District. Before any expenditure is made it must first be approved at a meeting of the District Council, with a request to be signed by its Chairman to be submitted to the Treasurer of the Tribal Council who will prepare the necessary purchase orders and vouchers.

The following Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 8, 1960, with a vote of 20 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3 (a) and (h) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 21, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
