

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1128

WHEREAS, Mr. Peter Aguirre, of Sells, Arizona, now has a business lease on 4 acres of tribal land, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Aguirre wishes permission to operate a service station and garage on the property, but such an operation is not authorized in the present lease, and

WHEREAS, The Council talked over the matter with Mr. Aguirre at the September 2 meeting, and is satisfied with the way he plans to operate, and with his promise to put up attractive buildings and to keep the premises neat and attractive, and

WHEREAS, the Sells District Council has approved Mr. Aguirre's application.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY The Papago Tribal Council that it grant permission to Mr. Peter Aguirre to operate a service station and garage on the property he is now leasing from the Papago Tribe, and to erect a building or buildings which may be needed to carry on this business, and

LET IT FURTHER BE RESOLVED that Mr. Aguirre's business lease be amended to include permission for this business operation, which will be subject to any applicable Bureau or tribal regulations, and

FINALLY, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Papago Tribal Council be authorized to sign any papers which may be necessary in connection with this resolution approved by the Council.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on September 2, 1960, with a vote of 19 for, 0 against & 2 not voting during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (e) & (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
