

**RESCLUTION** OF THE PAPAGO COURCIL

WHENTAS, In connection with the relocation of Sil Murs Village on the Cila Bend Reservation, it may be necessary to have a survey made of the village and the surrounding area that has been occupied by the Papagos for many years, and

WIERLAS, Such a Survey may be very important in helping the Gila Pend Papagos secure the housing they were promised by the U. S. Engineers, and

WHISKEAS, The cost of such a survey may be as much as \$400.00, and

WHITEAS, At a meeting held on September 20, 1960, at which a quorum was prosent, the file Bond District Council approved this expenditure out of District funds, by a vote of 6 for, and O against.

THERIPORS, LET IT HE REGOLVED by the Papago Tribol Council that it approve the expenditure of up to CACO.CO of Cile Bend District funds for a survey of the village and surrounding area that has been occupied by Papagos, this survey not to be made unless it is considered necessary, and to be made at as small a cost as possible.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on October 7, 1960, with a vote of 16 for, and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936; and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuent to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 924). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Rection 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
