

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1139

WHEREAS, The Pinineo District Council met on November 12, 1960, with a quorum present with the following villages represented: Santa Cruz, San Simon, Kukp, Chindit Kuk, and Pinineo; the Council decided to appropriate a supplemental amount of \$500 from the District funds for the 1961 fiscal year to repair wells or pump engines in the Pinineo District, and

WHEREAS, The supplemental appropriation was unanimously approved by the District Council since there was a balance of \$1,048.43 in the Pinineo District account as of October 31, 1960, with no expenditure for the month of November; and.

WHEREAS, There will be a balance in the Pinineo District funds account for the 1961 fiscal year after approving the additional budget as follows:

Balance - October 31, 1960: . . . . .	\$1,048.43
Appropriation for chiles repair	\$250.00
Supplemental appropriation for wells or pump engines	\$500.00
	<u>750.00</u>
Balance:	\$298.43

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RECDLVED By the Papago Tribal Council that the additional budget of the Pinineo District be approved as follows: \$500.00 from the District funds to repair wells, or pump engines in the said District.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on December 2, 1960, with a vote of 21 for, and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) and (b) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 924). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
