

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1143

WHEREAS, Marvin Enoe, Route 1, Box 300, Casa Grande, Arizona, a resident of Chuichu Village, has submitted an application dated December 2, 1960, asking the Council to grant him an assignment of 60 acre plot No. 73 on the East Chuichu project, which has been relinquished by John Hillman, and

WHEREAS, Marvin Enoe is a member of the Papago Tribe, 25 years of age, and physically capable of doing the heavy labor necessary to farm this assignment, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Enoe states he can get seed, fertilizer and other financing from local businesses in Casa Grande to get started, and with the additional help of his family and the Papago Agency, he believes he can be a successful operator, and

WHEREAS, The Council understands there is no longer any lien against the land by the Farmer's Home Administration, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Robert Howard, Agency Soil Conservationist stationed at Chuichu, told the Council that the B. I. A. are prepared to give Mr. Enoe technical assistance, and that he believes Mr. Enoe has a chance to make good so that he can pay the water charges of \$22.00 per acre.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED By the Papago Tribal Council that it approves the transfer of relinquished assignment No. 73 on the East Chuichu project to Marvin Enoe in accordance with his application, and that it authorize the Papago Agency to take whatever steps are necessary to make this assignment official.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on December 2, 1960, with a vote of 21 for, and 0 against, during a meeting of which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (c) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 964). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
