**RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL**

RES. NO. 1349

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council by Resolution No. 1348 has approved an application by the Arizona State Museum, University of Arizona, Tucson, Arizona to conduct Archaeological explorations at the Fortified Hill Site on the Gila Bend Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe and the Gila Bend Reservation, with the assistance of the Papago Indian Agency, plan to develop this site as a tourist attraction, and a study by professional park and tourist specialists should be made to determine what facilities are needed at this site and to recommend by which method this tourist attraction can best be operated, and

WHEREAS, it is fair and reasonable for the Papago Tribe to make a contribution to the development of this site which will provide income for both the Tribe and the Gila Bend District.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council hereby requests and urges the Bureau of Indian Affairs to have such a study made so that the development of the tourist facility at this site may begin as soon as possible after the Arizona State Museum finishes its explorations there.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby orders and directs that the sum of \$500.00 be made available immediately to help defray the cost of the study that is required for the development of this project, and that the Tribal Treasurer is ordered and directed to pay over this sum for this purpose.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on March 6, 1964, with a vote of 16 for, 0 against, and 2 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested by the Council by Section 2 (1) and Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to transmission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and by-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
