

**RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, Ruth M. Adams, Tribal Secretary, was hired by the Papago Tribe in October 1963 as Assistant Tribal Secretary and her hourly pay rate at that time was set at \$1.50, and

WHEREAS, Miss Adams served in this position until the Tribal elections in February 1964 when she was elected as Tribal Secretary, and

WHEREAS, Miss Adams is the only typist employed in the Tribal Office at this time and does all of the Office correspondence, as well as the Council Minutes and acts as Secretary at Tribal Council meetings, and

WHEREAS, because Miss Adams now holds the responsible position of Tribal Secretary and is a Tribal Officer, it is felt that her hourly pay rate should be increased to \$1.65, and


WHEREAS, provision has been made in the Tribal 1964 Fiscal Year Budget for this increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby grants and approves an increase in the salary of Ruth M. Adams, Tribal Secretary, from \$1.50 per hour to \$1.65 per hour, thereby making an annual salary of \$2,478.00, commencing with the present pay period, and hereby orders and directs the Papago Tribal Treasurer to prepare and issue the necessary vouchers showing such increased pay figure.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on April 3, 1964, with a vote of 10 for, 0 against, and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 904), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1936.
