

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

Tribe

WHEREAS, Papago Tribal Judge Cipriano Manuel resigned as Tribal Judge in December 1963, and

WHEREAS, on December 24, 1963, Lloyd Ignacio of Sells was appointed Tribal Judge by the then Acting Superintendent of the Papago Indian Agency, under authority vested in him by Chapter 1, Section 2, of the Papago Law and Order Code, said appointment to be subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the Papago Council, and

WHEREAS, the said Chapter 1, Section 2, of the Code provides that each Judge shall hold office for a period of two (2) years unless sooner removed, and

WHEREAS, the said Lloyd Ignacio has served since December 1963 in the capacity of Acting Judge and has performed the duties of that office in a fair, impartial and capable manner, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council, by Tribal Resolution No. 1341 on December 6, 1963, accepted and approved the resignation of Cipriano Manuel from his position of Chief Tribal Judge of the Papago Tribal Court, said resignation to be effective as of December 20, 1963.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby confirms, accepts and approves the appointment of Lloyd Ignacio as Chief Tribal Judge of the Papago Tribal Court, said appointment to run until April 3, 1966, unless sooner removed, in accordance with the provisions of the Papago Tribal Law and Order Code.

The above Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on April 3, 1964, with a vote of 17 for, 0 against, and 4 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (e) and Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
