RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1964

WHEREAS, Trice Electric Co-operative, Inc. of Tucson has applied to the Papago Council for a power line right of way 20 feet wide to serve electricity to the Villages of San Simon and Pisinimo on the Papago Reservation, and

WHEREAS, this proposed line is to extend from Covered Wells to San Simon with another line extending from the junction of Highway 86 and Pisinimo Road to Pisinimo Village, a total of approximately 25 miles, and

WHEREAS, Pisinimo District Council has already passed a Resolution, granting the right of way within its District without charge, and

WHEREAS, the consumers of electric power in the Villages of Pisinimo and San Simon will be allowed a lower rate of payment in the event that there is no charge for the right of way, and the Tribal Office has already notified the Trice Electric that there will be no charge for the right of way.

NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council herein and hereby grants to the said Trice Electric Co-operative, Inc. a power line right of way 20 feet wide to serve electric power to the Villages of Pisinimo and San Simon, the proposed line to extend from Covered Wells to San Simon with another line extending from the junction of Highway 86 and Pisinimo Road to Pisinimo Village, a total of approximately 25 miles, said right of way to be granted without charge.

The above Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on June 5, 1964, with a vote of 22 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
