

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1378

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 964 of the Papago Tribal Council, passed in 1957, authorized the setting aside of the sum of \$10,000.00 for research work and other expenses in connection with the Papago Tribe's claim, Docket No. 345, pending before the Indian Claims Commission, and

WHEREAS, the claims came on for hearing before the Indian Claims Commission on February 24, 1964, the oral testimony is now completed, and the filing of briefs by the opposing parties is now awaited, and

WHEREAS, in connection with said claims case the Claims Attorneys, Marks & Marks, have employed the services of a competent anthropologist, Dr. Bernard L. Fontana, for an agreed sum of \$10,000.00, plus expenses, with which agreement the Papago Tribe has been familiar, and

WHEREAS, the sum of \$5,000.00 has heretofore been paid to Dr. Fontana to apply on said agreement and the Tribe has reimbursed Marks & Marks for expenses incurred by Dr. Fontana and the attorneys' office in the sum of \$2,072.50 which covers expenses incurred to January 1, 1963, and

WHEREAS, the additional sum of \$5,000.00 became due to Dr. Fontana on February 24, 1964, and in connection with expenses being incurred for duplicating of exhibits, maps, etc., additional expenses have been incurred by Marks & Marks since January 1, 1963 totalling over \$1,000.00 for which it has not yet been reimbursed by the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, in connection with the hearings in Washington, D. C. additional expenses were incurred for travel and lodging by Dr. Fontana and Marks & Marks in the approximate sum of \$1,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the Papago Tribal Council that, in addition to the sum of \$10,000.00 heretofore set aside for research and other expenses in connection with the presentation of the Papago claim before the Indian Claims Commission, the additional sum of \$5,000.00 be paid to Dr. Bernard L. Fontana, being the balance now due to Dr. Fontana for his services in connection with the Land Claims Case.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Amended Attorneys' Contract between the Papago Tribal Council and Marks & Marks, which said Contract was last amended on January 21, 1960, be further amended to provide that the maximum expenditure for all research and other expenses, including the services and expenses of Dr. Fontana, be increased to \$15,000.00.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on August 7, 1964, with a vote of 18 for, 0 against, and 4 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 988), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior,

pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
