

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1379

WHEREAS, at its meeting in May the Papago Tribal Council voted to dissolve the San Xavier Water Users Co-operative Association and to cancel a present outstanding balance of \$8,531.47 which the Association owes to the Papago Tribe, and

WHEREAS, it now appears that the Constitution and By-Laws of the San Xavier Water Users Co-operative Association provide that, in the event the Association should be dissolved for any reason, such action can only be accomplished through an appropriate and proper Resolution of the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council has given consideration and study to this matter.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby orders and directs the immediate dissolution of the San Xavier Water Users Co-operative Association, and further orders the immediate cancellation, annulling and voiding of the present outstanding balance of \$8,531.47 or in whatever other amount owed by the said Association to the Papago Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on August 14, 1964, with a vote of 14 for, 0 against, and 7 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f), Section 3(a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act. of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
