

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1387

WHEREAS, receipts of the Papago Tribal Herd for the 1963 fiscal year are estimated at \$15,130.00, and

WHEREAS, the Budget for the 1963 fiscal year has been carefully reviewed and it does not appear practical to reduce it any more in view of range conditions, and the efforts of Tribal officials to up-grade the calibre of the livestock for breeding purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council hereby accepts, approves and confirms the 1963 fiscal year Budget of the Papago Tribal Herd, as submitted, and authorizes the Tribal Treasurer to sign purchase orders and vouchers in the amounts provided in the attached Budget against properly designated accounts.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on September 4, 1964, with a vote of 21 for, 0 against, and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
