NOW, THRESPOSE, LET IT BE MESSLYED, that the Papage Tribal Commonth hereby accepte, approved and confirms the 1965 fincel year Budget of the Papage Tribal Herd, as submitted, and authorises the Tribal Treasurer to sign purchase orders and venchors in the amounts provided in the attached Budget against properly designated accounts.

The foregoing Resolution was duly emoted by the Papage Council on September 1, 1964, with a vote of 21 for, 0 against, and 1 met voting, during a meeting at which a querum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Council tution and By-Imms of the Papage Tribe ratified by the Tribe on Secumber 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Seculation is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papage Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Countitution and By-Laus of the Supage Tribe.
