## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COMMETL

AES. NO. 1392

WHEREAS, The Papage Tribe had on deposit with the U.S. Treasury as of September 30, 1964, an unchligated believe of \$119,417.78, and

MMMRAS, the operating funds of the Tribe are at a low she and are barely sufficient to meet the bare minimum obligations of the Tribe, and

WHERES, it is thought by inferred officials of the Tribe that within a resonable period of time the balance of the Tribe's operating funds will commune to increase and will eventually reach a figure comparable to the figure of the balance as established six neeths ago, and

MMMAS, at recent meetings of Tribel and Agency officials, called to study god to improve the present finantial condition of the Tribe, it was agreed that the sun of \$8,000.00 be withdrawn at this time from the U.S. Treasury funds of the Tribe, with the thought that perhaps at a later date this sum slight be re-deposited in the Treasury funds.

NOW, THERSTORE, LET IT BE RESELVED, think the Papage Germail hereby enders and directs that the sum of \$6,000.00 he immeditately withdrawn from the funds of the Papage Tribe new on deposit with the U.S. Treasury and deposited in the current operating funds of the Tribe, to be used for the purposes of the General Fund of the Tribe.

The above Resolution was daily emasted by the Papage Scannil on Sevenher 6, 1964, with a vote of 20 for and 0 against, during a mosting at which a quarum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Securit by Section 3(a) and Section 3(b) of Article V of the Constitution and Ry-laws of the Papage Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1976, and appeared by the Sections of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1974. Said Resolution is effective as 35 the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papage Agency and 12 subject to resolution by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Secretary of the Papage Tribe.
