**RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL**

RES. NO. 132

WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe had on deposit with the U.S. Treasury as of September 30, 1964, an unobligated balance of \$119,417.78, and

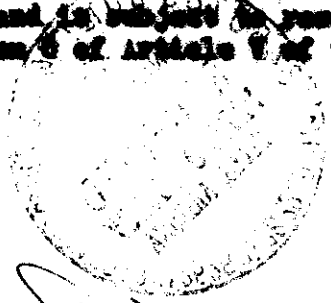
WHEREAS, the operating funds of the Tribe are at a low ebb and are barely sufficient to meet the bare minimum obligations of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, it is thought by informed officials of the Tribe that within a reasonable period of time the balance of the Tribe's operating funds will commence to increase and will eventually reach a figure comparable to the figure of the balance as established six months ago, and

WHEREAS, at recent meetings of Tribal and Agency officials, called to study and to improve the present financial condition of the Tribe, it was agreed that the sum of \$8,000.00 be withdrawn at this time from the U.S. Treasury funds of the Tribe, with the thought that perhaps at a later date this sum might be re-deposited in the Treasury funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby orders and directs that the sum of \$8,000.00 be immediately withdrawn from the funds of the Papago Tribe now on deposit with the U.S. Treasury and deposited in the current operating funds of the Tribe, to be used for the purposes of the General Fund of the Tribe,

The above Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on November 6, 1964, with a vote of 20 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3(a) and Section 3(h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to reconsideration by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
