

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1395

WHEREAS, Papago Tribal Resolution No. 1391 was duly adopted by the Papago Council on October 9, 1964, and

WHEREAS, through an inadvertence, the said Resolution No. 1391 was not approved by the Papago Indian Agency within the required time, and

WHEREAS, said Resolution No. 1391 provided for the grant by the Papago Tribe for a power line right-of-way to serve electricity to the Villages of Vaya Chin and Gu Ve on the Reservation.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby re-adopts and re-affirms the provisions of Tribal Resolution No. 1391 previously adopted by the Papago Council.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Papago Council herein and hereby grants to Trico Electric Co-operative, Inc. of Tucson a power line right-of-way for two power lines, the first line to extend from the Village of San Simon to the Village of Vaya Chin, commencing in the Pisinime District, passing through the Gu Achi District, and ending in the Hickiwan District, and the second line extending from the Village of Pisinime to the Village of Gu Ve, commencing in the Pisinime District and ending in the Gu Ve District, said right-of-way to be granted without charge.


The above Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on December 11, 1964, with a vote of 20 for, 00 against, and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984.), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to re-cession by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
