RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Res. No. 1436

WHEREAS, From time to time the education committee has expanded in its educational activities, and

WHEREAS, It has been brought to the attention of the Papago Tribal Council that the education committee with its members have a great burden within its activities concerning the many facets of education, and

WHEREAS, Robert C. Nackett, Cipriano Manuel, and Marjorie Fuelle have resigned from the committee and left it vacant, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has filled these vacancies with Mary Grace Lucas, Enoa Francisco, Jr., and Betty Ann Rivas.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED By the Papago Tribal Council that Mary Grace Lucas, Enoa Francisco, Jr., and Betty Ann Rivas be installed as members of the Papago Education Committee.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on January 7, 1966, with a vote of 16 for, 2 against, and 3 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 13, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
